On 10/31/2025 at approximately 1901 hours, Officers responded to 2921 Cougar Path NW for a harassment complaint. Mary Teresa Frantz DOB: 07/10/1967 was reporting that Charles Joseph Johnson DOB: [REDACTED] was using his pick-up truck and trailer to block her driveway, and was harassing people.

I arrived in the area and located Johnson near 2830 Cougar Path. Johnson was seated in his [REDACTED] [REDACTED] He was pulling a small trailer with a political sign in it. I spoke with Johnson who stated the following in summary:

- He is out trick or treating with his children.
- He is driving his truck along following them to stay out of the rain.
- He is on the Prior Lake School board and is supporting a new candidate.
- He is pulling a small trailer with sign for that person.
- He stopped near Frantz residence.
- She approached his vehicle.
- He was seated inside with the door closed.
- She opened his drivers door and began yelling at him.
- She advised him he is not allowed to have the political sign or be in their neighborhood.
- He asked her to let go of his door so he could close it.
- She did not and was yelling at him how he is not welcome.
- She told him she was going to call the police on him and he asked her to call.
- He was able to pull his door shut and drive away.
- He was alarmed how she was acting in front of his children.
- He was alarmed that she also opened his truck door to yell at him.
- He was on the public roadway trying to enjoy the night with his children.
- He has served with Frantz on the school board for approximately one year.
- She typically acts like this towards him.

Johnson provided me an Axon recorded statement. He stated similar as above.

It should be noted that at the time of the call it was dark cold and raining. The street was lined with parents in vehicles following along with their children trick or treating.

Officer Peerboom spoke with Frantz to get her side of the encounter.

I issued and mailed a citation to Frantz for the following:

On 10/31/2025 at approximately 1901 hours, Officers responded to 2921 Cougar Path NW for a harassment complaint. Mary Teresa Frantz DOB: 07/10/1967 was reporting that Charles Joseph Johnson DOB: [REDACTED] was using his pick-up truck and trailer to block her driveway, and was harassing people.

I met with Frantz at her residence. The truck and trailer were no longer blocking the driveway. Frantz told me the following information in summary:

- Her and Johnson are both on the school board and tend to not get along
- Johnson parked his pick-up truck pulling a trailer with a political/campaign sign in front of her driveway blocking the driveway
- Johnson was handing out candy and campaign information while blocking her driveway
- She approached Johnson's vehicle and a door was slightly ajar
- She opened the door the rest of the way, and told Johnson to stop blocking the driveway or she would call for Police
- She did not yell or scream at Johnson as the interaction was very short
- Johnson did the same thing the previous Halloween

It should be noted my conversation with Frantz was recorded using Axon Audio.
